# **Road Safety Plan and Policy**

# 1. Policy Statement

The purpose of this Road Safety Plan and Policy is to establish comprehensive guidelines to ensure the safety of Dr. Qaisar Ali Associates employees, contractors, and stakeholders during transportation-related activities.   - 2. Security threats in high-risk areas.
  - 3. Weather forecasts and visibility conditions.

Ensure vehicles are equipped with necessary safety gear, including:

1. First aid kits.

2. Fire extinguishers.

3. Emergency communication devices.

4. Spare tires and repair tools.

Assign trained and experienced drivers familiar with defensive driving techniques.

#### Vehicle Inspection and Maintenance:

Perform daily vehicle inspections using a standardized checklist to verify:

1. Tire condition and pressure.

2. Brake functionality.

3. Lights and indicators.

4. Fuel and fluid levels.

Schedule regular vehicle maintenance in accordance with manufacturer recommendations.

#### Safe Driving Practices

**♣** Enforce adherence to the following safe driving practices:

1. Always wear seat belts and ensure all passengers do the same.

2. Follow speed limits and adjust speed according to road and weather

conditions.

3. Maintain a safe distance from other vehicles.

4. Avoid using mobile phones or other distractions while driving.

5. Refrain from driving during extreme weather conditions unless

absolutely necessary.

## Fatigue Management

**♣** Establish the following guidelines to prevent driver fatigue:

1. Limit driving shifts to a maximum of 8 hours per day.

2. Ensure drivers take a 15-minute break every 2 hours of continuous

driving.

3. Avoid scheduling trips during late-night hours unless critical.

#### **Emergency Preparedness**

♣ Develop and communicate emergency response procedures for road incidents,

including:

1. Vehicle breakdowns.

2. Road accidents.

3. Security threats such as robberies or blockades.

♣ Provide drivers with emergency contact numbers, including local authorities,

medical services, and company representatives.

Equip vehicles with emergency kits containing essential items such as water,

flashlights, and blankets.

#### **Monitoring and Reporting**

**↓** Install GPS tracking systems in all company vehicles to monitor:

- 1. Vehicle location and route adherence.

- Conduct post-incident investigations to identify root causes and implement corrective actions.

#### Supervisors

- Verify trip readiness by ensuring vehicle inspections and pre-trip planning are complete.
- Conduct toolbox talks to emphasize road safety before trips.

#### **Drivers and Passengers**

- ♣ Comply with all road safety policies and procedures.
- ♣ Report any hazards, incidents, or unsafe conditions immediately.
- ♣ Assist in emergency response efforts when needed.

## 6. Communication and Training

- ♣ Conduct regular awareness sessions on road safety policies and procedures.
- Provide new hires with comprehensive road safety inductions.
